

Village of Breton Business Licence Bylaw No 16-01

On February 10, 2016 the Council of the Village of Breton enacted a “Business Licence Bylaw”. The purpose of the “Business Licence Bylaw” is part of the 39/20 Alliance Strategic Plan with the goal of:

- Creating a business directory for the 39/20 Alliance members, Breton, Warburg, Thorsby and Calmar to promote business to business opportunities while raising the profile of the regions businesses.
- Issuing Regional Business Licences to qualified businesses to increase inter-community business opportunities, and promote economic development.

There is **no cost** to obtain a local Village of Breton Business Licence. Application forms will be available at the Village Office, on the Village Web Site www.village.breton.ab.ca, and mailed to known business owners. The Business Licence Bylaw comes into effect on the first day of April, 2016.
