On February 10, 2016 the Council of the Village of Breton enacted a "Business Licence Bylaw". The purpose of the "Business Licence Bylaw" is part of the 39/20 Alliance Strategic Plan with the goal of:

- Creating a business directory for the 39/20 Alliance members, Breton, Warburg, Thorsby and Calmar to promote business to business opportunities while raising the profile of the regions businesses.
- Issuing Regional Business Licences to qualified businesses to increase intercommunity business opportunities, and promote economic development.

There is **no cost** to obtain a local Village of Breton Business Licence. Application forms will be available at the Village Office, on the Village Web Site <a href="www.village.breton.ab.ca">www.village.breton.ab.ca</a>, and mailed to known business owners. The Business Licence Bylaw comes into effect on the first day of April, 2016.
